**COMMON CONSTRUCTION
PREVAILING WAGE RATES FOR GUAM**

Pursuant to 8 CFR 214.2(h)(6)(v)(F)(2), U.S. Citizenship & Immigration Services (USCIS) must approve specific wage data and prevailing wage rates used for construction occupations on Guam. The following wage rates apply only to H-2B workers and similarly employed U.S. workers on Guam. USCIS has reviewed the Government of Guam’s proposed rates and issued an approval in a letter to the Director of Labor on November 6, 2017.

These rates shall be effective for Temporary Labor Certifications filed on or after November 20, 2017.

These prevailing wage rates are effective for both new and extension temporary labor certifications. The prevailing wage rate on applications approved prior to implementation of these new rates shall remain in effect for the duration of the existing labor certifications.
