RESOLUTION NO. 13-004**

***A RESOLUTION RELATIVE TO THE APPROVAL OF GWIB POLICY BRIEFING  
SERIES FOR WIA TITLE IB – GWIB BRIEFING SERIES 2013-001***

**WHEREAS**, Guam submitted its 5-year Workforce Integrated Plan for PY2012-2016 on September 17, 2012. An addendum was subsequently provided on November 16, 2012 for concerns on items regarding Guam's State Plan and these items were justification for WIA Waiver Requests for 1) Waiver of the required 50% employer contribution for customized training; 2) Waiver of Section 123 that requires that providers of Youth Program elements be selected on a competitive basis; and 3) Waiver of Section 133(b)(4) to increase the allowable transfer of funds between Adult and Dislocated Worker funding streams allocated.

**WHEREAS**, On December 7, 2012, Guam was granted a conditional approval from US DOL ETA for the 5-year Workforce Integrated Plan for PY2012-2016 excluding waiver requests and the pending Memorandum of Understanding for all partners of OSCC (One Stop Career Center) concerning operation of the One Stop delivery system.

**WHEREAS**, the Agency for Human Resources Development is the administering entity of the Workforce Investment Act funded programs as authorized under Executive Order 2011-08;

**WHEREAS**, on February 12, 2013, the Planning and Coordinating Standing Committee Chair recommended that Policy Briefing series be endorsed by the Board where the briefing series is intended to provide an archiving mechanism and serve as the overarching communication policy for the GWIB and the Agency for Human Resources Development.




