REPATRIATION BOND STANDARD RATES

A survey was conducted using reputable internet sources to determine airfare rates from Guam to specific countries. As a result of the survey, the following rates were developed to be used as standard rates for determining the amount of Repatriation Guarantee Bonds.

SINGAPORE, Changi	\$396.00
SOUTH KOREA, Seoul	\$315.00
TAIWAN, Taipei	\$317.00
THAILAND, Bangkok	\$392.00
TURKEY, Istanbul	\$989.00

These rates shall be effective for all Temporary Labor Certifications filed in Guam after 03/13/2023 and shall remain in effect until <u>03/12/2025</u>.

In cases where no Standard Rate has been established, the employer may submit documentation from a Travel Agent, Airline or Reputable Internet Source as to the high season, economy class rate from Guam to the alien's Point of Origin. GDOL reserves the right to accept or reject the employer's rate in favor of rates researched by ALPCD.
