## 2025 LOWER LIVING STANDARD INCOME LEVELS (LLSIL) FOR GUAM

### ACTION: NOTICE

Title I of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) (Pub. L. 113-128) requires the U.S. Secretary of Labor to update and publish the LLSIL tables annually, for uses in the law (including determining eligibility for youth). WIOA defines the term "low-income individual" as one whose total family income does not exceed the higher level of the poverty line or 70 percent of the LLSIL.

The following chart depicts the 2025 Lower Living Standard Income Levels for Guam:
