About the Program

The Dislocated Workers Program supports individuals who have been laid off or are unemployed by providing resources to help them get back to work. We offer job search assistance, career counseling, skills training, and support services to help you re-enter the workforce quickly and confidently.

Whether you're looking to enhance your skills or transition to a new industry, we're here to guide you every step of the way.

Eligibility

You may be eligible for the Dislocated Worker Program if you are 18 years of age or older and find yourself in any of the following situations:

- **Veterans get priority of service**
- Have been terminated or laid-off from employment
- Were self-employed (to include farming, ranching, or fishing), but are now unemployed as a result of general economic conditions in the community in which you reside or because of a natural disaster
- Are a displaced homemaker
- Are going through disrupted employment

On-the-Job Training (OJT)

On-the-Job Training (OJT) provides individuals with hands-on experience while working in a real-world environment. This program allows participants to learn job-specific skills directly from employers, combining practical training with mentorship. Upon satisfactory completion of the training program, employers are expected to retain you as a regular employee.
