NAVFAC Pacific awarded a \$28.5 million contract to Hensel Phelps Construction Co. of Honolulu, Hawaii for the construction of a power upgrade at Joint Region Marianas, Guam. The work to be performed includes construction of an underground electrical transmission and also includes underground distribution lines, modifications to electrical substations and reprogramming of data acquisition systems.

Work is expected to be completed by March 2020.
