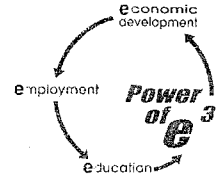

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ELIGIBLE TRAINING PROVIDER LISTING PURSUANT TO RFP NO. WIA 10-001

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS, amid the concerns for which the Guam Workforce Investment Board (GWIB) continues to include support building effective partnerships and promoting training and education activities.

WHEREAS, in July 2010, the Guam Workforce Investment Board, Planning and Monitoring and Finance and Technology subcommittees reviewed the recommendations from the Guam Department of Labor/Agency for Human Resource Development (GDOL/AHRD) program review committee for the Eligible Training Provider Listing (ETPL), and

WHEREAS, the availability of training and education courses is a requirement pursuant to the Workforce Investment Act Public Law 133(b)(5)(B)(i)(ii), and, an actionable strategy of Goal 3 of the modified plans of work for years 2009-2010, promoting the learning continuum by bringing together public and private partners to promote and develop a skilled workforce in support of new economic development and economic opportunities for Guam and the region, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Guam Workforce Investment Board hereby approves the Eligible Training Provider Listing (ETPL) for the Youth, Adults, Dislocated Workers, Incumbent Workers & Senior Citizens (YADIS) programs to cover years 2010-2013, subject to annual recertification, and further approves the same training providers be used for other demand training initiatives deemed necessary by the Guam Department of Labor/Agency for Human Resources Development.


