



**GUAM WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 2018-001**

**A RESOLUTION RELATIVE TO THE APPROVAL OF THE USE OF STATEWIDE FUNDING
ALLOCATION FOR THE ONE-STOP OPERATOR**

WHEREAS, the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) was signed into law on July 22, 2014, reauthorizing the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) of 1998; and

WHEREAS, the Guam Workforce Development Board (GWDB) supported and approved Resolution 2017-006 on June 28, 2017 to recognize the Government to Government approach for the procurement of the One Stop Operator selection; and

WHEREAS, the One-Stop Operator shall be located at the Guam's comprehensive American Job Center (AJC), and shall be responsible for the day-to-day operations and management of the AJC for the delivery of workforce development services to job seekers, employers and business entities for the WIOA and Wagner-Peyser Employment Services (ES), Veteran Services, Vocational Rehabilitation Services, Adult Education and Family Literacy Programs and other programs and services; and

WHEREAS, the WIOA Joint Final Rule requires that states follow the same policies and procedures they use for procurement; and

WHEREAS, 17 CGA allows for a Government to Government consultation approach for the procurement of a One-Stop Operator in accordance with WIOA as set forth in Title 2, Chapter II, OMB, Procurement Standards, Sections 200318 through 200.326; and

WHEREAS, the GWDB acknowledges the need to sponsor for the selection of the One-Stop Operator with the estimated statewide funding allocation of \$150,000.

RESOLUTION

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Guam Workforce Development Board (GWDB) adopt the Resolution for the approval of the Statewide Funding for the One-Stop Operator selection.
