About the Program

The American Job Center offers career training programs to help young adults get employed, pursue further education, or both. These programs support eligible young adults across Guam every year.

Depending on what you qualify for, we can help you with valuable resources that can assist you :

- Explore career options and the skills needed for various occupations.
- Develop essential job skills, including conducting job searches, creating resumes, and preparing for interviews.
- Access opportunities for work-based experiences, such as internships, summer programs, apprenticeships, and mentoring.
- Identify community resources to support planning and achieving transition goals.

Eligibility

- **Veterans get priority of service**
- 14 - 21 years of age
- Currently attending school
- Meet federal income guidelines
- Eligible to work in the United States
- Posses a barrier to employment:
 - High-school drop out
 - Pregnant/Parenting teen
 - Homeless
 - Runaway Youth
 - Foster Child
 - Individual with a Disability



Program Benefits

Work Experience (WE) Benefits

The Work Experience Activity invites youth to step into the professional world, offering hands-on training to build essential work readiness skills. Participants gain valuable insights by experiencing the daily challenges and rewards of a real workplace. Whether paid or unpaid, this program provides up to 480 hours of immersive learning to prepare for future career success.

Year-Round In-School Youth (ISY) Program

The Year-Round In-School Youth Program empowers students to achieve their educational and career goals throughout the school year through paid workshops and internships. Designed for youth aged 14-21, the program provides academic support, career exploration, leadership development, and work-based learning opportunities. Participants gain valuable skills, access to mentoring, and guidance to prepare for a successful transition to college or the workforce—all while staying engaged in their education.
